## TIP 1

If your child is not sure where to start, take a look at our prompts and choose one to get the creative juices flowing.

- Can you share the story of when you first discovered the library?
- What is your favorite book or genre to read and why?
- What 3 books would you bring with you to a deserted island?
- Can you share a story of your favorite librarian?
- Choose your own library prompt!



## TIP 2

Choose a location with ample lighting and position the camera horizontally at eye or above eye level. Choose a medium shot, 4 - 5 feet, or a long shot, 5 - 7 feet for your video.



## TIP 3

For better balance, use the rule of thirds when filming and make sure to keep your child within frame.



## TIP 4

Keep the camera steady and start filming! Take as many tries as needed and support your child during their performance.



## TIP 5

Keep video submissions within the range of 30 seconds - 3 minutes for the best chance to shine!
