Choose a location with ample lighting and position the camera horizontally at eye or above eye level. Choose a medium shot, 4 - 5 feet, or a long shot, 5 - 7 feet for your video.

For better balance, use the rule of thirds when filming and make sure to keep your child within frame. Keep the camera steady and start filming! Take as many tries as needed and support your child during their performance.

TIP 4

Keep video submissions within the range of 30 seconds - 3 minutes for the best chance to shine!
